

SCANNING KEY CONTENT

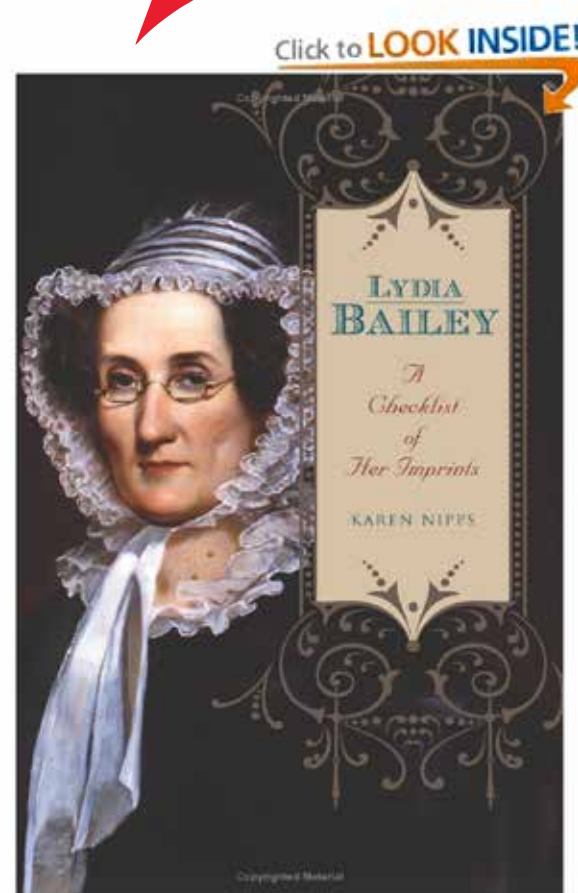
Four librarians from three different Harvard Libraries have been working to demonstrate the feasibility of scanning selected content of items at the time of accessioning and cataloging. The basic idea is “simple” – scan key parts of an item, deposit the images into a

digital repository and add links to the record to enable those images to be displayed in the OPAC. We anticipated a straight path for our “simple” project but our journey had many twists and turns!

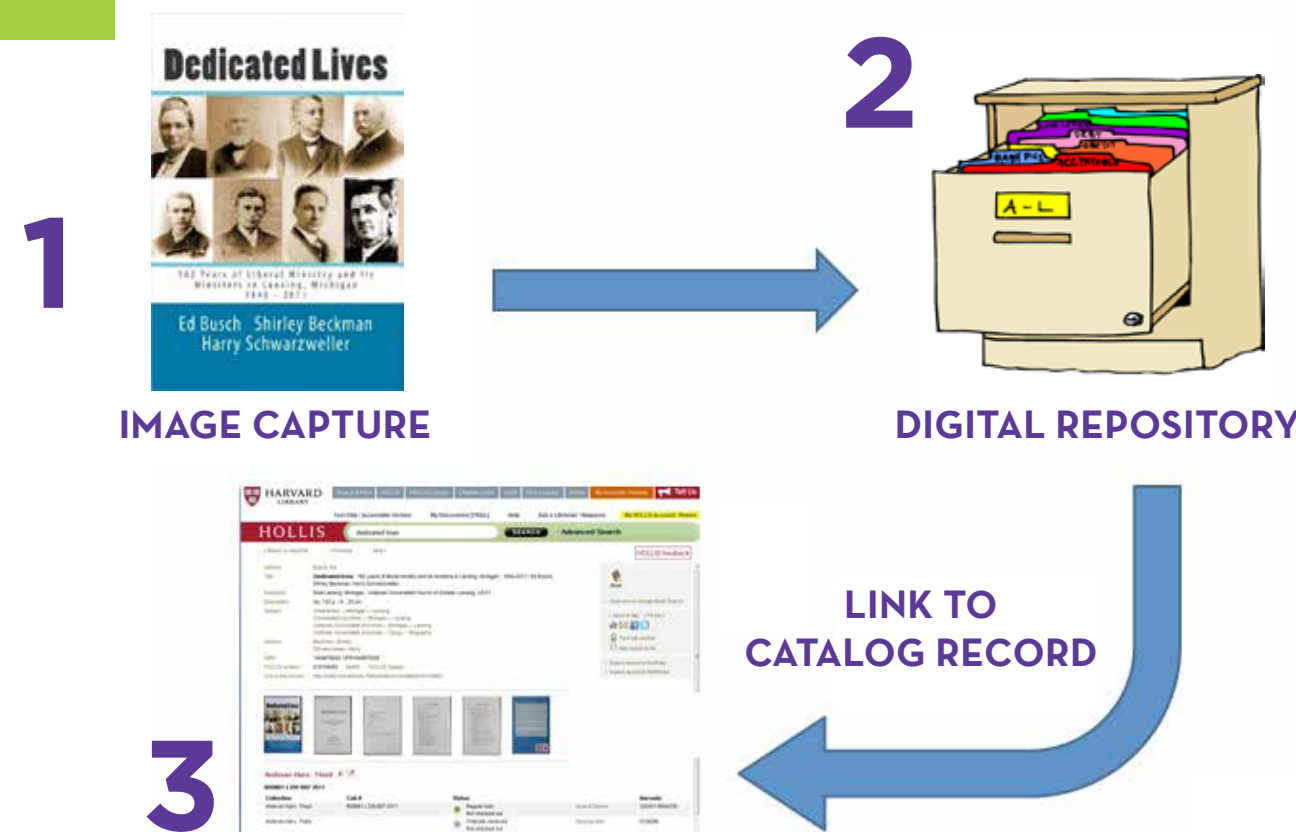

File naming structure:

A system that is helpful in identification and is machine-actionable

Fair Use and Copyright: Consult experts

MACRO MAGIC

Excel: Using the deposit report, split the filename into component parts, expand partcode for labeling OPAC image, combine elements for complete 856

MacroExpress: take system number and completed 856 from spreadsheet, pull up holdings record, copy and paste complete 856 into local cataloging system

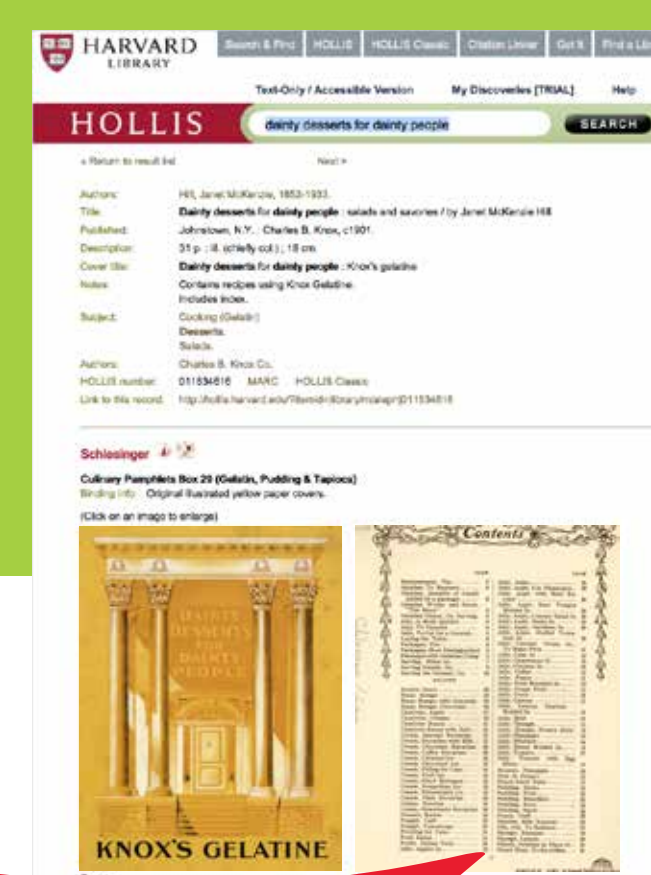
