Transcription Tool for Teaching and Research Progress Report, March 1, 2013

Project Summary

The goal of this project is to identify a transcription tool for use at Harvard from the many candidates already available. After a first phase spent assessing user needs, existing tools will be reviewed and evaluated with the object of meeting user needs and ensuring that the tool can successfully integrate with Harvard's Library and academic computing systems.
